Program requires someone who:

- Has mechanical aptitude and interest in manufacturing
- Can complete/pass a drug test
- Can lift and carry 50 pounds
- Can meet strict attendance policy
- Possesses Basic English and math skills (minimum 7th grade level)
- Meets low-income eligibility guidelines
- Is a minimum of 18 years of age and lives in Seattle
- Has a desire and is able to work full time
