- Can lift and carry 50 pounds
- Can meet strict attendance policy
- Possesses Basic English and math skills (minimum 7th grade level)
- Meets low-income eligibility requirements
- Is a minimum of 18 years of age and lives in Seattle
- Has a desire and is able to work full-time

- Classes are Monday through Friday, 11:30 am - 5 pm, for 12 weeks
