



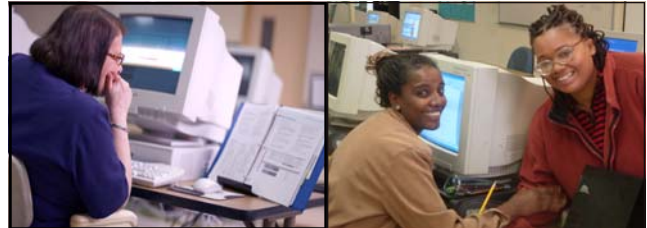

Adult Basic Education (ABE), including math, reading, & basic computer literacy,
English as a Second Language (ESL), with a work preparation focus.

Cornerstone is for individuals who:

- Are planning to enroll in Sector or Sector Pathways Training
 - Tested at or below 235 on the CASAS Test
 - Need basic, entry level computer skills
 - Require improved Math skills to succeed in training
- Must improve their English reading, writing, & speaking skills



To Enroll, students must:

- Have a letter of referral from their CBO Case Manager
- Go to SSCC Workforce Development Office before 11am, M-Th to enroll, (Robert Smith Building, room 81)
- Make sure to bring a paper & pen for class that day!
- *Cornerstone Class is M-Th, 12:30-3:30pm*
- *CMs please check in with students in class at least 1x/week*
